

## Camping trip Info:

Drive up for the day or stay the weekend! The Sierra Foothills Amateur Radio Club fall campout will be held September 22-24, 2017 at Stampede Reservoir, CA. Bring a camp chair, tent, hammock, sleeping bag or a mega RV... All are welcome!

We checked out the Logger Campground last weekend and the paved detour road in from hwy 89 was easily navigated by even the largest Class A and 5th wheels. A few miles of the road are 1 1/2 lanes, but the speed limit is set at 20 mph, good line of sites on the corners and traffic was light even in July. The road trip from Auburn took a little over 1 1/2 hours with the RV and a trailer. No heavy construction vehicles on the road or noise in the campgrounds as the booking site suggested. The semi-open campground canopy has plenty of tall pine trees for HF antenna wires and most sites are very near the beautiful lake. Very nice, clean and well maintained campground. New RV dump station available before the drive out!

Members should consider reserving camping spots in advance at the [www.recreation.gov](http://www.recreation.gov) website for the Logger Campground, CA. Single spaces are \$23 per night. Potable water is available curbside. Many sites are available and being near the end of the season, likely will have drive-up spots available for last minute arrivals.

Brian (AI6US) and wife Lin will host a free pancake/ eggs / sausage / OJ breakfast on Saturday morning for all advance sign-ups at space #90. BTW... this is a double site on the lake and we would be happy to share the extra-large lot size with a few tents and/or another small RV.
